Ken gave his background and explained that there had been a death in the club affecting the proposal that had necessitated a work around. His club annually hosts the Peach State Star Gaze which is a money maker, where in the past has had Ruukl speak. People asked questions about the weather and specifically the temperature in Atlanta this time of year. The response was that light pollution was not like up north.

They were also looking to combine the talks so that the ALPO group would not be separate from the AL talks. There was some more general discussion that followed.

Carroll took a poll on members liking to start the convention on a Wednesday as this year and the council meeting on Tuesday. Hands favored starting on Wednesday however the members in the audience did suggest that the more important speakers be later in the week on Thursday – Saturday.

Also being considered for the convention were the Fernbank Science Center, the Jim Cherry Planetarium and the possibility of using the AAC observatory as a trip. Accommodations at the Marriott Courtyard. Atlanta Decatur Downtown/Emory was estimated at \$119.
