2017 Horkheimer/Parker Youth Imaging Award Entry Rules:

- Nominee must be an Astronomical League member under the age of 19 at the time of the nomination.
- Completed form must be submitted with the image (jpeg format) by the award deadline of March 31, 2017 to <u>HorkheimerParker@astroleague.org</u>
- Image must have been taken by the nominee within the past year.
- Image must not have been captured using an online telescope.
- Only one image per nominee, please.
- Please submit the image in a high resolution jpeg format.
- Please submit a photo of the nominee, preferably in an astronomical setting, in jpg format.
- The nominating sponsor must be either an Astronomical League Regional officer or Astronomical League astronomy club officer.
- The winning images may appear in the Reflector magazine, on the AL website, and on the AL Facebook page, and they may also be used for Astronomical League promotional purposes.
- Judges decisions are final.

Horkheimer/Parker Youth Imaging Award:

The Horkheimer/Parker Youth Imaging Award honors the late Don Parker of Coral Gables, Florida. Dr. Parker had a lifelong interest in astronomy, especially in the art of astrophotography. Among his many accomplishments, he was a director of the Association of Lunar and Planetary Observers (ALPO) and served on the board of that organization.

This award recognize the imaging accomplishments of Astronomical League members who are younger than 19 years of age at the time of the nomination.

The first place winner will receive a \$1000 check and plaque, second place a \$500 check, and third place a \$250 check.
