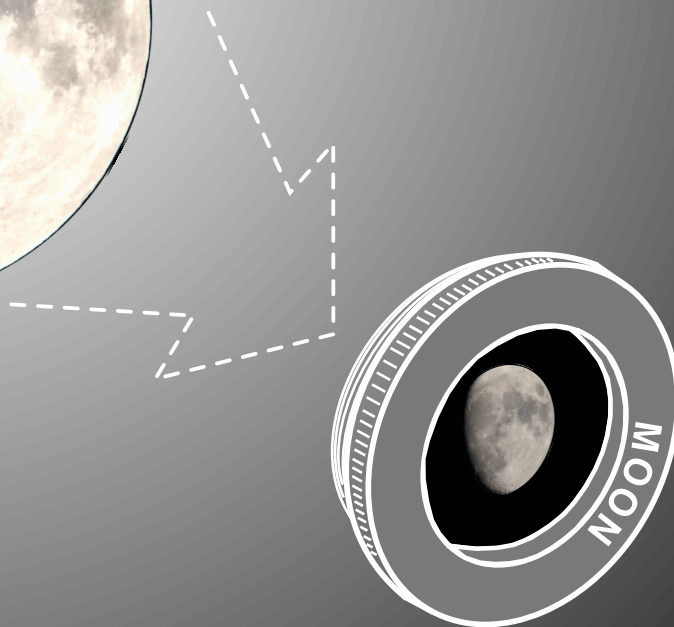




*Exploring the moon!*

## Sunglasses at Night?



Moon filters are probably the least expensive astronomical accessory. They are very useful – almost essential really – when the moon's phase is between waxing fat gibbous through full then on to waning fat gibbous. What percentage of incoming light is transmitted for a typical moon filter for an amateur telescope?
