


Muscleman Cluster



This large open cluster is often overlooked in favor of its two more splashy neighbors – the famous Double Cluster.



How to find the Muscleman Cluster, aka Stock 2:

- 1. Find the "w" shaped constellation Cassiopeia and its neighboring constellation to the southeast, Perseus. Identify its brightest star, 1.8 magnitude Mirfak.
- 2. Mid way between the center star of the "w" (Gamma Cas) and Mirfak lies a soft glow.
- 3. Binoculars aimed at the glow reveal the famous Double Cluster, also called NGC 869 and 884, and h Persei and Chi Persei.
- 4. Place the Double Cluster near the southern edge of the field. Near its center is Stock 2, the Muscleman Cluster.
- 5. The Muscleman is about 1° in diameter and contains 50 or more stars of 8th magnitude or dimmer. Through binoculars, it appears as a large grainy glow north of the Double Cluster.
- 6. While the Double Cluster lies in Perseus, the Muscleman sits just across the border in Cassiopeia.
