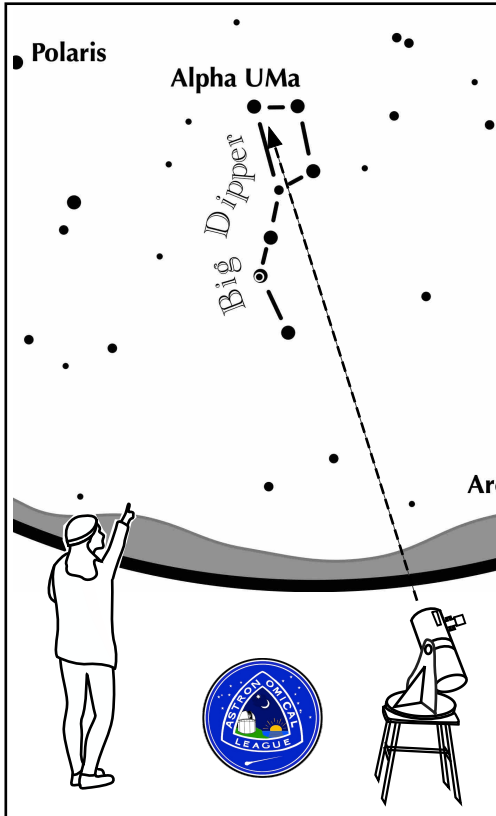

Other Suns: Alpha Ursae Majoris

How to find Alpha Ursae Majoris on a March evening

Face northeast. Look for the Big Dipper standing upright on its handle. Alpha is the star on the upper left corner of the bowl.

Alpha UMa

A-B separation: 381 sec

A magnitude: 2.0

B magnitude: 7.0

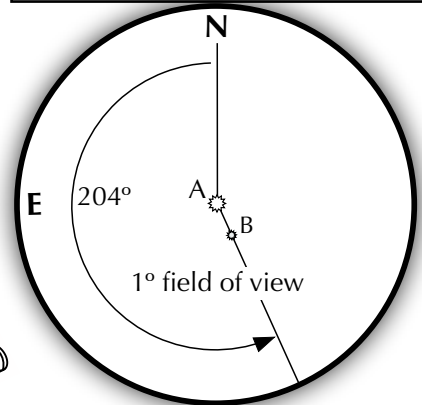
Position Angle: 204°

Colors:

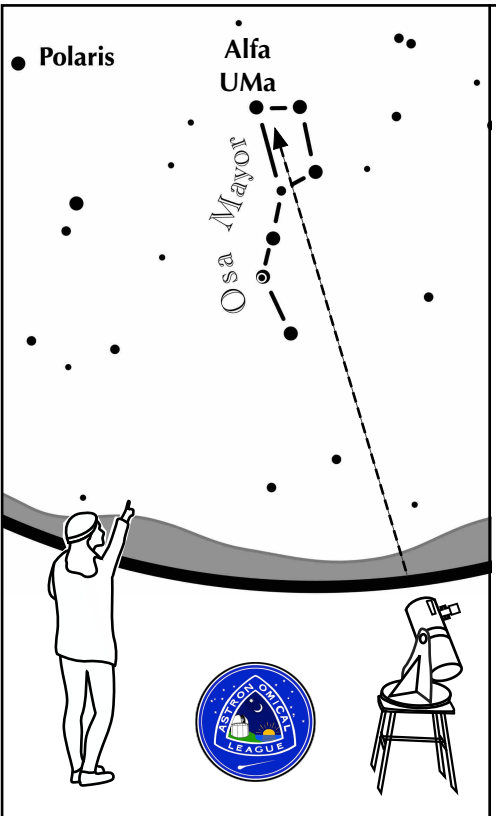
orange

Suggested magnification: >20x
Suggested aperture: >3 inches

B magnitud: 7.0

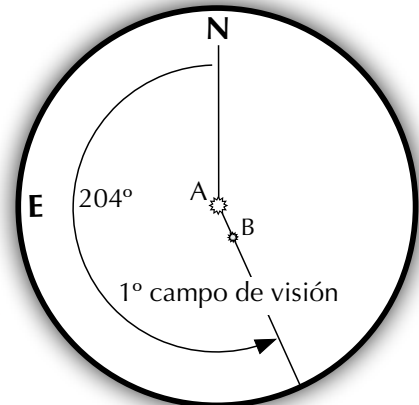
PA: 204°
