Al Nagler. Icon & Innovator. A true friend of amateur astronomers.

What did Al Nagler mean to amateur astronomy?

He not only believed, but he repeatedly demonstrated that the eyepiece is as important to telescope performance as the primary lens/mirror.

He was an innovative optical designer who kept innovating. In 1977 he introduced the groundbreaking Tele Vue Nagler eyepieces giving an 82° apparent field with very good edge definition. Recently, the Tele Vue team introduced the Nagler Type 7 series with sought after long eye relief.

He was a generous donator to many, many astronomy events around the US. He was a teacher, an explainer who in 5 minutes or less could clearly describe the whys & hows of Tele Vue products.
