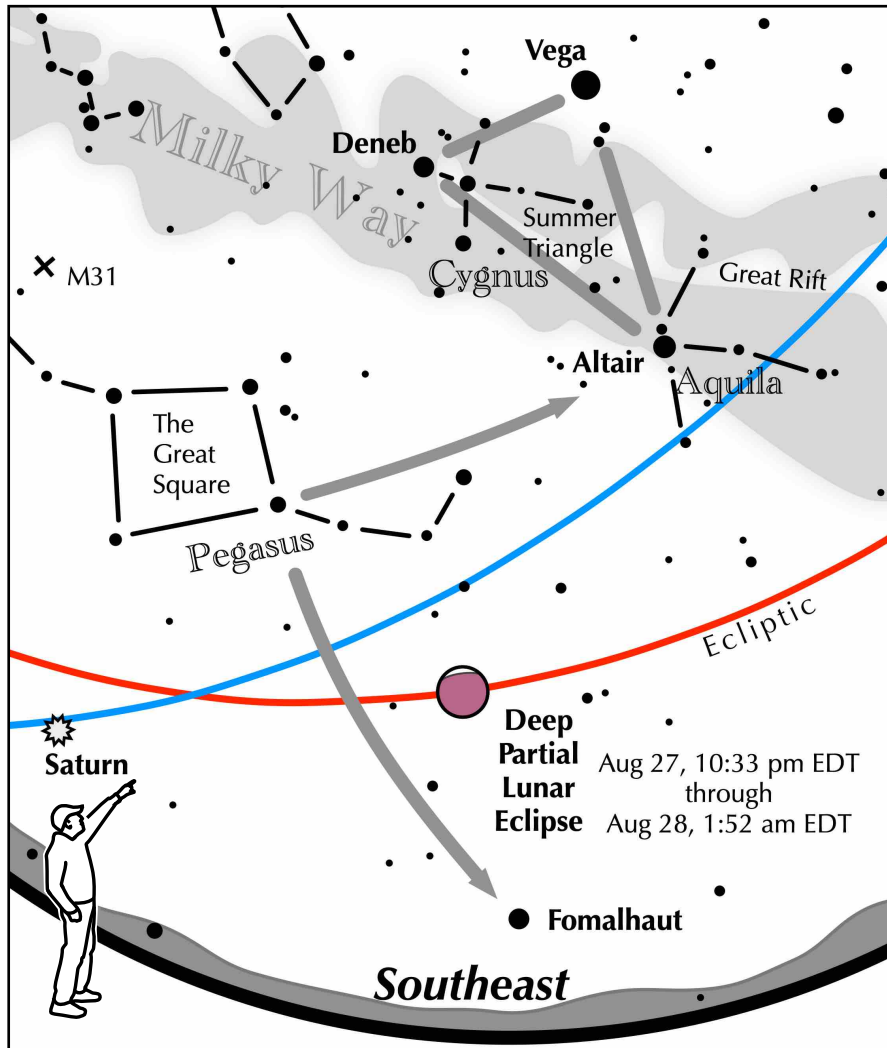
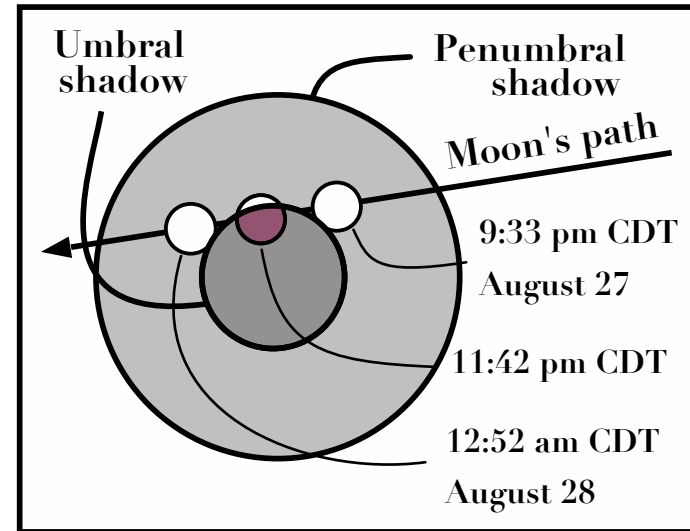


If you can observe only one celestial event in the evening this August, see this one.

on August 27-28
Mid eclipse: Aug 27, 11:42 pm CDT**



The Moon slides through a deep partial eclipse

In the late evening hours on August 27 into the early morning hours on August 28, the brilliant full moon slides into Earth's shadow.

- Even though the partial umbral eclipse begins at 9:33 pm CDT on Aug 27, any dark bite might not be noticed for another 5 minutes.
- At mid eclipse (11:42 pm CDT Aug 27) when 93% of the moon lies in the umbral shadow, what color is the moon? How red is it?
- Do you notice that the shadow's edge is not straight, but curved?
